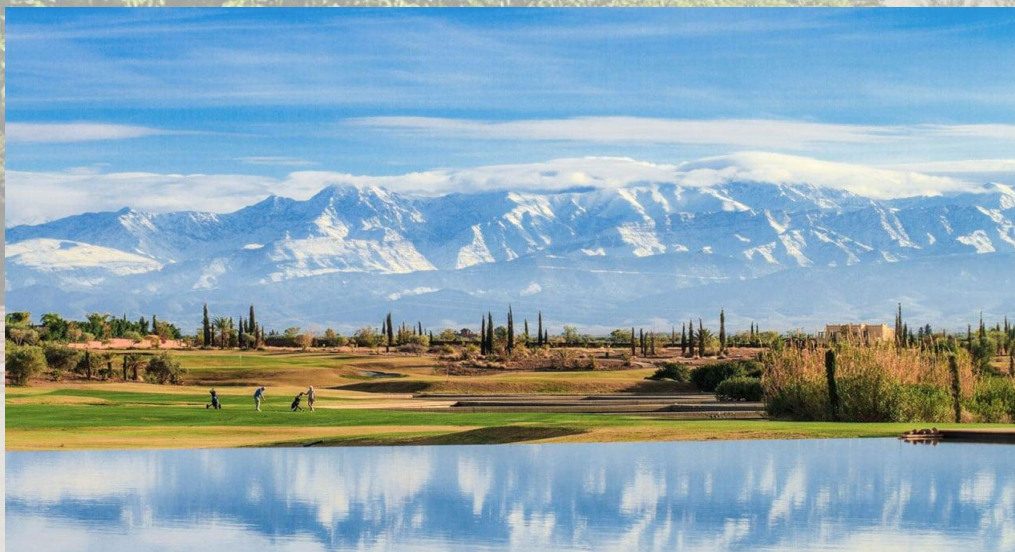
Golf AL MAADEN



A unique, modern 18-hole golf course in the heart of an undulating natural setting, facing the peaks of the Atlas Mountains.

Al Maaden golf course is designed to be original and playful, thanks to a number of unique features, including rectangular ponds in homage to the Menara gardens and custom-made monumental sculptures that adorn the course.

Nestled in the heart of a verdant oasis, these 75 hectares

ASSOUFIT Golf



The course winds through naturally undulating terrain, sheltered by the snow-capped Atlas Mountains, 20 minutes from Marrakech. For his first golf course design project, Scottish designer Niall Cameron's vision was to create a desert-style golf course through palm trees, cacti and olive groves.

A unique oasis at the foot of the Atlas Mountains

Noria Golf Club is by far the most original course Hills & Forrest has ever designed.

The concept of creating 3 different atmospheres (orchards and lavender, desert zone and an "oasis") was a challenge, but once achieved, it creates a wonderful golfing experience for players.

Treed with cypress, eucalyptus, palm, olive, orange and apricot trees, its 27 holes make playing golf a real pleasure. An exceptional place that satisfies the desires of beginners and experienced golfers alike.



AKENZA Golf Marrakech



Marrakech is about to welcome a real gem for golf enthusiasts: Akenza Golf, a brand-new golf course scheduled to open at the end of May 2025.

This 18-hole course offers a unique experience that will appeal to both seasoned golfers and golf enthusiasts in search of new sensations.

Inspired by the Arizona style, Akenza Golf Marrakech features desert areas, dry wadis and obstacles sculpted by nature.

EXPLORE THE BAHIA PALACE : This stunning, intricate blend of Moroccan and Andalusian architecture has romance at its heart; built in the 19th century to honour Bahia, the minister Ahmed bin Musa's wife. It's one of the great places of the "Red City". Other great attractions in Marrakech are the enchanting **JARDIN MAJORELLE BOTANICAL GARDENS** famous for their lavish use of blue and that provided inspiration for Yves Saint Laurent; the stunning Madressa ben Youssef Islamic school and its ornate architecture; and — to get a flavour of the history and creativity of this timeless land- the opulent Dar Si Said Museum

For a full sense of the ancient way of life, head to the Medinah, or historic part of the city.
